When will the event take place?



animation, documentary, narrative, visual composition and civic engagement.


BEST STUDENT PROJECTS COMPETITION

How will winners be selected?

A diverse panel of judges – including ACCESS, iENGAGE and iEARN Moldova teachers, students and alumni – will select first, second and third place winners by voting for their favorite projects online.

BEST LESSON PLAN INVOLVING STUDENT MEDIA PRODUCTION

EFL teachers are invited to submit their lesson plans which include student media production.

Are accepted lesson plans which:

- Focus on students creating a media product, such as a video, a slideshow with voice, a cartoon, an animation, a video story, etc.
- Are part of an international project, such as iEARN projects.

What type of lesson plans can be submitted?

Any type of lesson plan which incorporates student media production using any of these tools: *Powtoon, Vimeo, Slide story, UtellStory, Voicethread, Blabberize, Narrable, Stupeflix, Movenote, Windows Movie Maker, DVolver, Animoto.*

What lesson plan formats are accepted?

The selection committee will accept the following lesson plan formats: traditional lesson plans in Word or PDF formats, lesson plans created using Power Point or Prezi, lesson plans created in video form, such as Powtoon or Movenote.

What structure should the lesson plans include?

The lesson plans should include the following sections: opening, objectives, introduction, guided practice, independent practice, closing, evaluation.
